The deadline for the application and essay is August 29, 2008 and must be physically in their office by 4:30 p.m. that day. A \$150.00 Application Fee must be attached to the application. Applicants must be:

- Member of a state of federally recognized Indian Tribe.
- Resident of Alabama
- High School senior or attend college and be between the ages of 17 and 23.
- Single with no children (not widowed or divorced).
- Have a 3.0 or higher over all GPA.
