***Essay: 300-500 words in length.**

- Spelling, grammar, punctuation, and good paragraph structure apply.
- Typed or neatly written in ink.

***Poster: no larger than 11”x17”.**

- Good use of imagination, color, and design.
- Clearly answers the question.

***Video: 30 seconds to 1 minute in length.**

- Imaginative, interesting, and creative.
