The purpose of the Pow Wow is to provide a family type gathering. Tools, vulgar items, and other goods that would more likely be offered in a flea market will not be permitted. Traditional weapons such as knives, arrowheads, spears, etc., will be allowed for sale, but must be exhibited in boxes, display cases, etc., out of the reach of children. **Under no circumstances should this type item be sold to a minor!** If this is abused, you will be asked to remove the items in question.
