The class meets each Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday in the Adult Education Library at 5:00 P.M. – 7:00 P.M. Students who are working day hours can come at 5:30 P.M.

We provide the books, calculators, tutoring services, and access to computers in the computer lab. Funding to pay for the cost of the new GED Test is provided for Tribal Members and First Generation student. You will be required to take the GED Test at a registered testing center, which is usually located at a local community college.

The test consists of four parts:

- Reasoning Through Language Arts
- Mathematical Reasoning
- Science
- Social Studies

You can choose to take one test at a time. At this time, the GED Testing Service is providing a discount for anyone that needs to retake a test.
