## **Cover art specifications:**

• Orientation: portrait

• Dimensions: 8.5in x 11in

Quality: 250 to 300 pixels per inch (ppi)

Format options: .png, .psd, .ai

## Alternatively, for a front and back continuous cover page:

Orientation: landscape (but image should be aesthetically divided down the middle)

• Dimensions: 17in x 11in

Quality: 250 to 300 pixels per inch (ppi)

Format options: .png, .psd, .ai

Note: Photographs taken using a mobile device will not be accepted. Please make sure to capture images using a high resolution camera to meet printing standards.
