The Office of Indian Energy is accepting applications for a 12-week summer internship at Sandia National Laboratories in Albuquerque, New Mexico. Current full-time undergraduate and graduate students who have a minimum grade point average of 3.0/4.0 and are familiar with Native American culture and tribal issues are eligible to apply.
