The scholarship is for women of any age, with any level of coding experience and wants to learn coding. They are looking for women who want to use their technical training and their creativity to make positive changes to the world through coding. The article <u>Karlie Kloss Wants YOU To Code</u> mentions that there were over 600,000 high paying computing jobs that were not filled last year due to lack of trained applicants. The training is provided through Learn.co Flatiron School's Stack Web Development Program. Students complete over 700 lessons and solve hundreds of labs to gain their mastery of programming fundamentals and to build fully functioning web apps and earn a digital portfolio of skills on GitHub.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Women
- No previous experience necessary
- Must be available to complete the course within 12 months (dedicate 15+ hours/week to classwork.
- Must be a U.S. Citizen (or willing and authorized to work in U.S.) in order to receive apprenticeship placement.

The length of the program depends on your level of commitment. The course can be completed in over 4-8 months.
