The National Academies of Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine's Christine Mirzayan Science & Technology Policy Graduate Fellowship Program

The program is taking applications now. The deadline to apply is September 8, 2017 and the 2018 session takes place from January 16, 2018-April 6, 2018. The program provides a \$9,000 stipend to be used for living expenses while attending the fellowship. Selected applicants spend 12 weeks at the National Academies in Washington, DC learning about the employment opportunities outside of academia and learning how scientist and engineers provide the technology in decision making for policies that help to make life better for all humankind.

Graduate and professional school students and those who have completed graduate studies within the last five years are eligible to apply. Areas of study include social/behavioral sciences, health and medicine, physical or biological sciences, engineering, law/business/public administration, or relevant interdisciplinary fields.
